



The Teaching About the 2016 Elections Conference is almost here!

When does the conference begin?

Registration/check-in and breakfast begin at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, September 24th.
The conference officially begins at 8:45 a.m. sharp.

Where is the conference located?

The conference will be held on campus at [Grainger Hall](#) located at 975 University Ave., Madison, WI, 53706. Please use the entrance on the corner of University Ave. and Park St.

Where do we park?

Parking is available in the garage located at Grainger Hall for \$12. If this lot is full when you arrive, alternate parking is available at the [State Street Campus Garage](#) located at 415 N. Lake St., Madison, WI, 53715.
Grainger Hall is [approximately a 6-minute walk](#) from the State Street Campus Garage.

Are meals provided?

Yes. Breakfast and lunch will be provided. Coffee and tea will also be available throughout the day.
There will be a variety of food options available to meet the needs of all dietary preferences and restrictions.

What is the schedule for the conference?
